NEW APPOINTMENTS TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION

Two open positions on the Planning Commission were filled by the Town Board Supervisors on April 9. From four applicants, Kenny Miller was appointed to a three-year term, ending 5/1/2010 (replacing Rich Stevens), and Ken Olstad was appointed to fill out the remainder of Commissioner Kevin Flaherty's term, ending 5/1/2008. The Commission has been very active this year in reviewing and making recommendations regarding building permits, conducting public hearings, developing and streamlining application procedures and forms, reviewing and recommending improvements to existing ordinances, and preparing for the comprehensive plan update required by the Metropolitan Council for next fall. Efforts of retiring members Rich Stevens and Kevin Flaherty are very much appreciated.

ANNUAL MEETING RECAP...by Cory Behrendt

The annual meeting was held on March 13th, following the close of Township elections. During the meeting, the Board reviewed the 2006 year including a historical analysis of Township finances. The planning commission provided a 2006 recap, and the Historical Committee presented the "History Wall" created for the Township. Many "Thanks" to the History Committee for the stunning display recognizing our history, while completing it solely from generous donations of town residents.

At the meeting, town residents voted to keep the tax levy for next year (2008) at the same level for the current operating year (2007). While township spending is limited by the total revenue, it can move funding between expense items to accommodate budget limitations. For 2007, the levy funded 83% of budgeted expenses; in 2008 the levy will fund 78% of budgeted expenses.

During the meeting residents directed the town Board by majority vote to:

- Establish a town hall rental policy/procedure and agreement
- Establish a 5 year continuous improvement plan for roads
- Complete landscaping around the town hall (\$?)
- Complete lighting of the Flag (approx. \$1,500) w/\$1,000 being donated by a citizen.
- Install a sound system/recording system (approx. \$8,000)
- Install parking stops, parking lines, handicap markings (approx. \$1,700)
- Install through building mail drop and staff mailboxes (approx. \$900)

Funds for the above items, approximately \$11,100, will come directly from township reserves added to the general fund. While the township is not required to complete these items, it does attempt to complete as many as possible, as time allows.

Next year's annual meeting will be held Tuesday March 11, 2008 at 8:15 PM, at the Eureka Town Hall.

ROAD PROJECTS FOR 2007

Each year the Township budgets funds to maintain roads and right of ways in the township. As typically done, maintenance it spread out across each quarter of the township. Maintenance funds are focused on those roads and areas that need the most maintenance. In addition, certain projects such as right of way maintenance, culvert repair, sign replacements, etc. are also planned and budgeted on a yearly basis.

WATERSHED NEWS ... by Gloria Belzer

North Cannon River Watershed Management Organization - The WMO has grants for cost sharing projects in the Trout Brook sub-watershed and the WMO is cooperating with the County's shoreland ISTS (septic) inspection and upgrade program. The WMO is working on water monitoring at the outlet of Chub Creek this year and has a small amount of money for education. Eureka Township has received a grant of \$5,000 from the Cannon River Watershed towards a water quality improvement project including stabilization activities such as rip-rap and erosion control blanket along Grenada Avenue tributary to Chub Lake. This grant must be utilized by the end of 2007.

Vermillion River Watershed Joint Powers Organization - Eureka Township must pass a resolution adopting the Vermillion River Watershed Plan and commit to carrying out the entire Watershed Plan including land use regulations or carry out selected portions of the Watershed Plan or defer the implementation of the Plan to the VRWJPO. If the local unit of government has not adopted a local water management plan by November 3, 2007, the VRWJPO has the authority to regulate land use according to their Watershed plan and rules per Minn. Stat. 103B.211subd. 1(3)(i)

DID YOU KNOW ABOUT EUREKA ORDINANCES

Both Township and County laws state it is illegal to use All Terrain Vehicles (ATVs) on township roads or ditches unless registered for farm use. Otherwise, they should be used only on your own property. (Ord. 4, Chap. 2, Sec. 16, page 88)

"No signs shall be erected, constructed, altered, rebuilt, or relocated, until a permit for the same has been issued by the Town Board" Please check this Ordinance concerning permits before a sign is put in place. (Ord. 3, Zoning, Chap. 8, pages 74-77)

A reminder--Burning Permits from Lakeville or Farmington Fire Departments are required before any burning larger than a recreational 3'x3' camp fire. The permit must be available to show at the time of burning. Allow a couple of weeks after applying for site inspection, review, DNR approvel. etc. for the permit to be issued.
