The Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on an amendment to Ordinance 3, Chapter 9, Fences at Eureka Town Hall, 25043 Cedar Avenue. (virtual attendance via Zoom is also available)

The full text amendment is available on the Township website

- \* What is a public hearing? Public hearings are meetings designed to gather input from citizens regarding a certain proposed government action or application before a government body.
- ❖ Why is the Township holding one? Minn. Stat. § 375.51 requires that a public hearing be held before the enactment of any ordinance adopting or amending a zoning ordinance.
- \* Why should I attend? Public hearings are meant to encourage citizens to speak and offer information regarding a certain proposed action.
- \* How are the citizens informed? Notice of the time, place, and purpose of any public hearing is required to be given by publication in the official newspapers of the Township (Dakota County Tribune and Sun This Week), at least ten days before the hearing. The complete notice must also be posted on the bulletin board located outside of the Town Hall on the south exterior wall.

# **National Flag Day**

In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed June 14<sup>th</sup> as the official date for Flag Day and in 1949, the U.S. Congress permanently established the date as National Flag Day.

The colors of the flag have important meanings. Red symbolizes hardiness and valor, white symbolizes purity and innocence, and blue represents vigilance, perseverance, and justice.

Many notice the American flag flying proudly at the Town Hall and at times question why the flag is at half-staff. The Township receives notifications from the MN Governor's Office as to when a flag should be lowered. Volunteers from Eureka Township have been kindly completing this task when needed. Anyone can sign up for notifications when such an order is issued, at the Flags at Half-Staff webpage of the Governor's Office.

- Are you aware of the All-terrain vehicle (ATV) laws in Eureka Township?
  - No person shall operate an all-terrain vehicle (ATV) on any public road or road rightof-way, such as ditches, within the Township.
  - No person shall operate an ATV on the Eureka Town Hall property, or school property.
  - No person shall operate his/her ATV in a careless, reckless, or heedless manner, which endangers other persons or their property.
