Renew Moratorium for Business Development Interim Ordinance

A motion by Supervisor Kenny Miller: To extend the moratorium- An Ordinance of the
Township of Eureka, Minnesota entitled "Land Use Regulations Interim Use Study Area
for all Property located in Eureka Township." for an additional 1 year- October 9, 2003.

Approval of Non Conforming Use Ordinance Summary

Nonconforming Use Permits. Motion seconded by Supervisor Connie Anderson.

Bev Topp asked the attorney about CUP areas that have not been enforced historically.
The attorney wrote: The city cannot become liable for failing to enforce the ordinance
however the issue should be reviewed to make the practice consistent with the
Ordinance.
