

EUREKA TOWNSHIP MINUTES JANUARY 8, 1996

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Schindledecker. Present were Supervisors Johnson, Kadlec, and Smith, Clerk Leine and Treasurer Schulz.

Supervisor Kadlec moved to accept the December 11, 1995 minutes as read, seconded by Supervisor Johnson and carried.

Supervisor Smith moved to invest the \$14,000.00 on hand, and add the \$2,000.00 for 1996 in a 6 month Certificate of Deposit. This motion was seconded by supervisor Kadlec and carried. The interest on this \$16,000.00 investment will be paid to the Township's MMDA account.

Supervisor Kadlec moved to accept the treasurer's report as read, seconded by Supervisor Johnson and carried.

Bill totalling \$10,038.86 were presented to the board for payment. Supervisor Johnson moved to pay these bills, seconded by Supervisor Kadlec and carried.

Martin Diffley, 25499 Highview Ave, Farmington, MN 55024 is asking the township to verify and sign a statement to the fact that there has been now weed spraying of the ditches along his land for the past 4 years. Mr. Diffley is asking the state and the federal governments to certify his land as organic. The town board searched records and bills pertaining to weed and brush removal. A motion was made by Supervisor Schindledecker as follows: The Township has found no record of spraying the ditches on 257th St. in section 21 for the past four (4) years. This motion was seconded by Supervisor Kadlec and carried.

Be it noted, the town board has informed Mr. Diffley to post signs in the ditches on the county and township roads, stating the fact that the land adjacent to these ditches are classed organic and that the ditches are not to be sprayed.

Crag Taylor, 2409 w 139th St., Burnsville, MN 55337, is asking if there is any buildable property on the 137.32 acres he owns at Essex and 235th St. in Section 11. Legal on this land is as follows: W1/2 of SE1/4 of Section 11, Range 20. The board determined there are two (2) buildable sites. One site must be clustered to either 235th St. or Essex Ave.

Supervisor Kadlec moved to allow long term C.U.P. that would hold all existing conditions and charge a one time fee of \$50.00. This would include all C.U.P.'s except mining and mobile homes. This motion seconded by Supervisor Johnson and carried.

Supervisor Johnson moved to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Smith and carried.
