Eureka Township Town Board Meeting October 12, 1981

Meeting called to order by Chairman Smith at 7:30. All were present.

His second request for two buildings 70 x 30 and 48 x 120 in L shape was denied he had not been approved by the P.C.A. Also some questions as to use of same and reception of same by residents of neighborhood. House permit was not issued at this time, but may be picked up later. (Tell public hearing held)

Tom Zweirs of 9390 267<sup>th</sup> St. asked for a permit to add to his garage 36 x 32, all approved.

Gary Ruddle 21810 Dodd Blvd. requested a permit to build a house on a 3.75 acre lot in section 6. Permit was held until heat loss was shown.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

Lunden's request for a temporary asphalt plant was withdrawn for the present.

Next zoning of parts of section 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 35 and 36 presently zoned R.R. 1 to be rezoned to Ag. Status. The Ebeling 80 acres were excepted balance to mapped out by County planner. This was made a motion by Johnson, seconded by George Sauber. Vote Johnson yes, Sauber yes, Smith yes, Zweber yes, Kadlec no.

A bid for seal coating was presented next. However Johnson had an engineer from State report that there was no need at this time to do this so it was dropped.

Rother was at the meeting and said he would make a report on roads he had graveled so we could present to the county for cost sharing. He also told of repairs and maintaining before winter and asked about hours of operation for snowplowing. He said we had enough gravel crushed for next year.

The question of Francis Zweber's successor was brought up and clerk was to publicize this matter in the Dakota County Tribune.

Kadlec brought up the right to farm ordinance. Johnson's motion seconded by Zweber to lay it over to November meeting passed.

Cheryl Schindeldecker asked for more permit books. Johnson said he could maybe print some cheaper than printers.

Motion by Johnson seconded by Smith to call county's attention to their local roads was passed.
