

EUREKA TOWN BOARD SPECIAL MEETING OCTOBER 18,1988.

Special meeting called to order by Chairperson Schindledecker. Present were Supervisors Curry, Kadlec, Larson and Lee, Clerk Leine and Treasure Schulz.

T C, Construction, Elko, request a building permit for Lot 1, Block 8 in Eureka Estates. House will be 41 x 40 with a 22 x 20 attached garage. Plot has been approved for building. Shoulders have been installed in the 2nd addition per request of Townboard. Value of house and garage was established at \$75300.00, a \$536.00 permit fee was assessed. Curry moved to grant permit contingent upon building inspector's OK of plans and house must be built on Lot 1, Block 8. Larson Seconded Curry's motion and motion carried.

Lee moved to adjourn special meeting for TC Construction,

Seconded by Larson and carried.

Chairperson Schindledecker called special meeting dealing with Animal Ordinance to order at 8 P.M.

Public commented that they were tired of meetings and wanted something done,, All persons at meeting agreed that something must be done to define the need for an Ordinance. Many citizens have never complained about the nuisance because they felt it wouldn't do any good. Other had complained to the offending neighbor but shouldn't have wasted the time.

George Johnson brought before the board State laws regulating animals. Some of terminology is old but the laws are still enforceable

Per State law the sheriff of any county is charged with enforcing these laws. Public then wanted to know why the sheriff didn't enforce state law Citizens felt that if the sheriff didn't answer the township the township should go to the country attorney and ask why state laws are not enforced

Curry placed a motion before the board as follows. Eureka town board is to contact Sheriff's Office in writing, asking the question "Is the Dakota Sheriff's Dept. going to or not going to enforce State Statues. If they are not going to enforce Statues, Eureka Township wants a written reply as to the reason. This response is to be returned to the township by Nov. 7, 1988. Kadlec seconded this motion and motion carried.
