

Eureka Township
Board Meeting
December 7, 1981

The board met at the town hall starting at 7:35.

Smith, Johnson, Kadlec and Sauber present.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by the clerk and approved on a motion by Johnson, seconded by Sauber.

The treasurers report was read and accepted, motion by Johnson, seconded by Kadlec.

Bills were presented. Johnson made a motion to pay all bills including MC Cluskey with a note "we do not wish to be billed for partial inspections". Also that \$1,000 of Rother's bill be taken from Revenue sharing. Seconded by Sauber and passed.

Johnson informed the board that the Lakeville Fire Contract is up and they are meeting tonight but he had asked to have the contract held up till their next meeting. Board members will try to attend to plead their case for a lower fee.

Mrs. Osterman and her lawyer Mr. Schide asked for a permit to build a 30' by 70' horse barn so they would not need a conditional use permit. Johnson made a motion to grant a conditional use permit with the limit of 10 animal units in the 30' x 70' barn. After several neighbors voiced their concern Kadlec seconded, the motion passed. Johnson made a motion to grant a permit for a 30' x 70' barn. Seconded by Sauber, all in favor.

Todd Bachman asked for a permit to build a 20 x 26 storage shed. Johnson made a motion to allow same, seconded by Sauber and passed.

Mrs. Lindelin came to ask if a mobile home could be moved into our township in a hardship case. She was informed they could not.

Ray Hall came to get a permit. As Smith had told him to go ahead and build it was approved on Johnson. Motion seconded by Sauber.

Mrs. Christianson came up to have the board sign their application for the agriculture preservation act for their farm.

To date three people have said they were interested in Zweber's job as supervisor, Topp, Lee and Laddusaw. Johnson made a motion to have them appear at the January meeting for an interview. Seconded by Sauber, passed.

Clerk was instructed to get a 1982 calendar.

Ordinance 22 was discussed and laid over to another meeting.

Johnson made a motion to appoint Arlene Ebeling to the planning commission to take Donna Rollins place and interview the other candidates in March. Seconded by Sauber. Vote Johnson yes, Smith no, Kadlec no, Sauber yes.

Kadlec made a motion to table the proposition until all people interested be interviewed. Smith seconded. Vote Johnson no, Sauber no, Kadlec yes, Smith yes.

Johnson made a motion that the township buy file folders and hire someone to set up a permanent file system. Sauber seconded, passed.

The town hall was broken into and Leine and Kadlec were told to repair same.

Meeting adjourned at 9:50.
