

1991 Town meeting

The 1991 town meeting (postponed from March 12) was held at the Eureka Town Hall March 19. Dick Lee was elected moderator. The minutes of the 1990 were approved as read.

Treasurer report was read by Gary Schultz. Gary had made up a detailed report he handed out. He explained that aids are being eliminated and this will show in the 1992 taxes. The legislature and the governor are working on a balanced budget and no one knows at this time what the decision will be.

There was no old business. Lee Topp pointed out that we should include the Northfield paper for our legal ads as well as the Lakeville Times and the Farmington Independent. This matter was left up to the board.

Cheryl then presented the budget for 1992. How the board arrived at these figures presented. Ambulance costs were explained. Also fire protection Lakeville increased 15 ½ % for a 2 year contract. 11 calls for Lakeville 7 for Farmington, Ken Miller brought up that fires that do not have a permit should be paid by the arsonist.

The airport was next and there was a long discussion. Ray brought up excess water and sewage problems that an airport would bring. Mary had attended hearings and found a lot of opposition at all hearings. It was pointed out a decision would be made this year as to site selection.

Cheryl then presented income figures for this 1992 budget, If aid are eliminated more would have to be made up by taxes. Budget \$143,800. Dietz made a motion seconded by Clark Smith to accept the budget as presented.

Since there was no further business Gary Gunderson made a motion to adjourn seconded by
