We have ben advised we could join in the Farmington cleanup and bring our rubbish and junk to the Dakota Electric station at a cost of about \$1,800.00 not interested.

Cheryl had a Farmington Fire report but did not have any report from Lakeville.

Ambulance charges were next. We had good reports on the service.

The county signs were next explained and charges for same. On a motion by Steve, seconded by George the matter was voted down on a voice vote.

Cheryl next explained financing for the 225th St Bridge.

The Friedges pit was explained that it was not a gravel pit but a mining permit.

Clerk presented a breakdown of taxes.

Since there was no further business the meeting was adjourned
