

The Annual Town Meeting, held in the Town of Eureka in the County of Dakota and State of Minnesota, at Eureka Town Hall on the 12th day of March, 1963 was called to order by the Clerk and Oren Storlie was then chosen to preside as Moderator at the meeting.

Clerk's minutes of last years meeting was read and accepted as read with one change. Treasurer's report was read and on motion by Joe Dunn seconded by George Sauber was accepted as read.

On motion, it was ordered, that the following sums of money be raised by tax upon the taxable property in said Town for the following purposes for the current year:

For Town Fund/ Motion by George Sauber Seconded Joe Dunn	\$300.00
For R.B. Motion by Leigh Mallery Seconded Henry Larson	\$7,000.00
Snow Fund	\$1,000.00

On motion by Henry Larson Seconded by George Sauber, that a housing project in Township. Central water and sewer and not over 2 homes to one acre. Motion carried.

On motion by Leigh Mallery, seconded by Henry Larson Ordinance that no homes have less than ½ acre of land and not over 5 on 160 acres of land and 5 or more homes constitute a housing project. Motion carried.

Motion by George Sauber seconded by M.O. Johnson that town board hire legal council to help them straighten the building code in Eureka Township.

This revised code to be presented at 1964 annual meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Joe Dunn Seconded by Leigh Mallery that the retiring treasurer O.T.Leine be given a rising vote of thanks for his 50 years of faithful service as treasurer.

Motion to adjourn.

Motion carried.
