Eureka Township Special Hearing Regular Meeting May 11, 1981

A special hearing was held preceding the regular meeting at 7:00 PM to consider Roxanne Klecher's application to establish a beauty shop in her home. Since there were no protests the meeting adjourned at 7:30.

Regular meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith at 7:30.

All members present.

Johnson made a motion to grant Mrs. Klecher a conditional use permit for a beauty shop. Permit seconded by Zweber. All approved.

Minutes of last meeting were read. Wording of the Tonsager (Quanbeck) property deal letter of conveyance was changed to conform to the resolution. Then accepted motion by Johnson seconded by Sauber.

Treasurer's report accepted as read and accepted.

Bills were presented. Johnson motion to pay all except lawyer Stewart out of general fund seconded by Zweber passed.

Jack Danner asked for a permit to build a house on 245th St. Johnson made a motion to grant same seconded by Zweber, passed.

Robert Eisele's request for a pole shed on his lot. Zweber's motion seconded by Johnson to grant same passed.

Sam Wick also wanted a pole shed permit. Granted on a motion by Johnson, seconded by Sauber.

Karen Ostlie made a request for a pole barn on their property. Approved on their property. Approved on a motion by Johnson and seconded by Sauber.

Glen Tousignant then asked for a pole shed permit. Also approved on a motion by Johnson seconded by Sauber.

Roger Wood representing Lundin Construction requesting a renewal of their conditional use permit to run a gravel operation on 235<sup>th</sup> St. Zweber's motion, seconded by Johnson, carried.

WM Adelman's request to move in a house to his farm. Johnson's motion to approve if inspected by two board members and compliance with shoreland ordinance Kadlec

seconded and passed. Johnson then made a motion to waive that part calling for inspection as the house is less than 20 years old and been seen by board members. Zweber seconded and it was passed.

Larry Goerger asked for a permit to build a pole shed. Zweber motion, seconded by Johnson, granted the permit. He also asked to buy three chalk boards at \$5.00 each from the Castle Rock School. Johnson's motion seconded by Kadlec, passed.

Cheryl Schindeldecker also wanted a blackboard. Johnson made a motion seconded by Zweber, carried.

Mr. Topp came to talk Castle Rock School they are incorporated and ready to sign papers. The tractor was bought and is mowing for the second time. The Castle Rock Community Club will take over turning on the electricity, pay the bill and take care of all activities at the Castle Rock School. Zweber made a motion to take \$500.00 from revenue sharing plus \$400.00 from Castle Rock Township and give to Castle Rock Community Club. Johnson seconded. All in favor.

Matt Fulton from the county office with a map showing flood plain area in the county and where shore line ordinances are enforced. Since some dwellings were not shown he took it back to show missing sites.

Mrs. Day appeared to register a complaint about Simon's horses and cattle setup. Over crowding, dead animals, manure pileup, poor fences, are a nuisance to neighbors. Johnson made a motion to have our lawyer send Simon's a letter to appear at our next meeting to answer charges. Zweber seconded, all in favor. It was also suggested that the chairman get in touch with the Humane Society.

The sludge and ash sites (2) in Eureka were talked over. All people should be encouraged to attend the meeting in Farmington June 10.

Johnson proposed that the clerk send a letter to the county commissioner and MET Council stating our opposition to sites in our township.

The clerk read ordinance 22 that had been published in Dakota County Tribune. Johnson made a motion to table a later date. Seconded by Zweber and carried.

Zweber made a motion to call Rother Construction and ask that no more grading be done this month and also to itemize the roads worked on. Johnson seconded. All approved.

Dust control was tabled until next meeting.
