

Eureka Township
Board Meeting
May 12, 1980

All members present at May meeting.

Minutes of April meeting approved as read. Johnson asked about Eureka Estates bond's and the clerk informed him that he had taken the bond's to lawyer Schmitz, but had not heard from him.

Also fence at Roger Roadways pit entrance was brought up and Zweber did not think it was good enough to send them their permit.

Treasure's report accepted as read.

Bills were presented. Johnson made a motion to pay Rother Construction \$2,200.00 from the general fund and the balance from revenue sharing. Seconded by Zweber. All approved. Johnson made a motion to pay Larson \$565.25 on gravel bill out of general fund; seconded by Sauber. All approved.

Mr. Swanbeck came before the board with a map showing a parcel of land he own's in Section 21 to be divided into seven lots. He was denied permission to establish the lots.

Charles Kalish requested a permit for a pole shed. Sauber motion seconded by Johnson, passed.

Thomas Heywood and Alice Davis appeared to ask a variance to permit a house belonging to Mrs. Davis to be moved to the Heywood property of 11.4 acres. The variance was denied and Johnson made a motion to grant a permit if she would purchase more land to satisfy the ordinance. The house must be inspected first and the building inspector will see that it is brought up to specs when it is moved in proposed location. Kadlec seconded. All approved.

Joe Simon's agent appeared to ask for a hay shed permit. Kadlec moved to grant seconded by Sauber.

Henry Larson requested a corn crib permit. Zweber motion. Seconded by Johnson, carried.

Delmer Peterson asked for renewal of his mobile home permit. Kadlec's motion seconded by Johnson, carried.

Jerry Stevens appeared to ask for a permit for a modular home. He was asked to appear at the next meeting as there was discussion as to the difference between a modular home and a mobile home. They were told to look into a double width home and the board would consider this type.

Donald Rogue and Robert Laddusaw were appointed to the Planning Commission.

Jerry Rother then came up to talk about roads. Zweber made a motion to have Jerry put up a barricade in Eureka Estates seconded by Johnson, All approved.

Road inspection May 31 Board members and Jerry.

Johnson made a motion to have roads dust proofed as soon as possible. Seconded by kadlec. All approved.

Sauber made a motion to have Bixby repair bridge on 247th St. and send bill to. Seconded by Zweber. All approved.

Zweber made a motion to ask for all the records of work done by Consulting Engineer on 225th St. Bridge pay them and then dispense with their services. Seconded by Johnson. All approved.

Kadlec and Zweber were appointed to the care of Castle Rock School and to ask other town (Castle Rock) for funds to help with expenses.

Smith will check on the cost of spraying ditches.
