Johnson made a motion to contact Rother to find out if we could pay him \$1,000 immediately and pay balance later. No second, so motion dropped. Johnson then made a motion to pay Rother \$4,945.31 by warrant. Zweber seconded. All approved.

Zweber made a motion to pay Engineer's bill of \$756.75 out of the general fund. Johnson seconded. All approved.

Johnson moved to pay Dakota County Tribune their bill seconded by Zweber. All approved.

Mr. Quanbeck appeared to ask permission to subdivide his property of 42 acres. Johnson requested to table request until the board could examine the proposed plat. Zweber made a motion seconded by Johnson. All approved.

Mr. and Mrs. Tom Ostlie appeared to ask for a permit to build a home on 267th St and Ipava. Johnson motion, seconded by Kadlec approved same request.

Larry Bell's request for a swimming pool approved on a motion by Johnson seconded by Zweber.

Rodney Schmidt appeared to ask for a solar home permit south of Chub lake. Johnson made a motion seconded by Zweber to grant this permit. All approved.

Eugene Karel then asked for a permit to build a garage at 23530 Jersey Court. Johnson's motion seconded by Zweber, carried.

Alice Davis then appeared to get a permit for a house to be moved in on Cedar South of the town hall. Johnson motion seconded by Zweber carried.

Mrs. Ed Ebeling then asked for a permit to build a pole shed on Denmark Ave. Granted on a motion by Zweber seconded by Johnson.

Bixby came with a question about bridge repair on the 247th St bridge. Zweber made a motion to repair the bridge by adding 40ft plus adding wings and add fill to upgrade corner. Johnson seconded. Passed 5-0.

Mr. Topp came and asked about Castle Rock School ground mowing and maintenance. Johnson made a suggestion to having an auction on school equipment. A motion by Zweber to give \$2100.00 to Castle Rock fund, seconded by Kadlec carried. The committee to take care of Castle Rock was to meet with Topp and Peterson to arrange for care of the property.

Smith reported on the cost of spraying roadsides was tabled until next year.

Mr. Doyle reported that homeowners in Eureka Estates are accepting the parkland from developer if their lawyer approves the conditions. Performance bond furnished by developer was to be released on advice of lawyer Schmitz.

Hilman Leine gave the road report that was a result of road inspection.

Some projects were postponed until we have more money in our account.
