

EUREKA TOWNSHIP MEETING JULY 10, 1983

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:30 P. M. BY CHAIRPERSON LEE PRESENT WERE SUPERVISORS CURRY, AND KADLEC, CLERK LEINE AND TREASURE SCHULZ.

CLERK LEINE READ THE MINUTES OF JUNE 12, 1989. CURRY MOVED TO ACCEPT MINUTE 5 WITH THE FOLLOWING CORRECTION TO THE GEORGE BARTOSH PERMIT REQUEST. "CURRY MADE A MOTION TO ALLOW THE STORAGE GARAGE IF BARTOSH SUBMITTED A LETTER FROM HIS ATTORNEY STATING HE WOULD NOT LIVE IN GARAGES. MOTION DIED FOR LACK OF A SECOND." KADLEC SECONDED MOTION AND MOTION CARRIED

KADLEC MOVED TO ACCEPT TREASURES REPORT AS READ, SECONDED BY CURRY AND CARRIED.

CLERK LEINE INTRODUCED BILLS TO TOTALING \$12071.83 CURRY MOVED TO PAY THESE BILL, SECONDED BY KADLEC AND CARRIED.

DAVE MEALMAN, 25201 CEDAR AVE SO., FARMINGTON REQUEST A PERMIT OF ADD A SCREEN PORCH AND REMODEL INTERIOR OF HIS HOME. A VALUE OF \$10,000 WAS ASSESSED WHICH CARRIED A PERMIT FEE \$117.00. KADLEC MOVED TO GRANT PERMIT SECONDED BY CURRY AND CARRIED

ART FREDRICKSON, DENMARK AVE., FARMINGTON REQUESTED A PERMIT TO ADD A 16 X 28 TO AN EXISTING POLE BUILDING A PERMIT FEE OF \$14.28 WAS ASSESSED. KADLEC MOVED TO GRANT PERMIT SECONDED BY CURRY AND CARRIED.

MR TURPENING HAS OBJECTED TO THE HIGHVIEW CHRISTIANIA LUTHERAN CHURCH ADDITION ON THE BASIS THAT MR CHARLEE BARNES IS NOT A LICENSED ARCHITECT, ENGINEER. SEE ATTACHED LETTER.

KELLI KRAUSE, 6950 PORTLAND AVE SO., RICHFIELD, ASKED THE BOARD IF THE PROPERTY AT 220TH ST AND DODD ROAD, EAST SIDE WAS A BUILDABLE PROPERTY. THIS PROPERTY HAS BE DETERMINED TO BE A BUILDABLE SITE. CURRY MADE A MOTION TO THE FACT THAT THIS PROPERTY IS BUILDABLE, SECONDED BY KADLEC AND CARRIED

CURRY MOVED TO PURCHASE A COPY OF THE TOWNSHIP LAW BOOK FROM THE MN BOOK STORE AT \$15.95 PLUS SHIPPING, SECONDED BY KADLEC AND CARRIED.

JOHN MANKE, BUILDING INSPECTOR FOR EUREKA TOWNSHIP HAS INSPECTED THE DAVID TOUSIGNANT PROPERTY AT 23590 CEDAR AVE. MR MANKE HAS FOUND MR TOUSIGNANT USING THIS PROPERTY AS A RESIDENCE. MR. MANKE HAS GIVEN WRITTEN NOTE TO TOUSIGNANT TO STOP. SEE ATTACHED LETTER.

GEORGE BARTOSH THREATENED TO FILE SUIT AGAINST TOWNSHIP FOR NOT GRANTING A PERMIT FOR A STORAGE BUILDING AT BLOCK 11, LOT 2 OF EUREKA ESTATES. CHAIRPERSON HAS TURNED ENTIRE MATTER OVER TO MPLS ATTORNEYS. SEE ATTACHED LETTER OF ACTION.

HILLMAN LEINE REQUESTED A PERMIT FOR A 24 X 32 POLE SHED ON HIS PROPERTY ON CEDAR AVE A PERMIT FEE OF \$10.00 WAS ASSESSED CURRY MOVED TO GRANT PERMIT, SECONDED BY KADLEC AND CARRIED.

MILLER CONSTRUCTION WILL FINISH 225TH STREET, DODD ROAD PROJECT SHORTLY. THE TREES IN SAUBER'S FIELD MUST BE REMOVED. BOARD AUTHORIZED MILLER TO DISPOSE IN PROPER MANNER.

BRIDGE SIGNS FOR 225TH STREET BETWEEN DENMARK AND ESSEX ARE IN AND WILL BE INSTALLED THIS WEEKS

TOWNSHIP HAS GIVEN MILLER CONSTRUCTION THE GO AHEAD TO MOW DITCHES
