The regular town board meeting was held July 13.

Called to order by Vice Chairman Zweber, Smith absent.

Minutes of the last meeting and treasurer report read and accepted as read.

Bills were presented.

Dale Mc Cluskey was on vacation so Bill Adelman at Gary Smiths suggestion called Dan Miller (Farmington Inspector) to inspect footings for his moved in house. Zweber made a motion to pay his bill of \$15.00 and withhold same from Mc Cluskey's bill. Seconded by Sauber and passed.

A letter from Lawyer Stewart in regards to the suit against G & T Trucking. Date for trial was set for August 12 and Stewart requested payment of his bill.

Johnson made a motion to pay all bills except Stewarts, seconded by Kadlec and passed. Johnson suggested that someone talk to Stewart about the bill and how much the total bill in the suit will be and Gary Smith was to take care of this matter.

Mr. Doerflor requested a permit for a pole shed for storage. Johnson's motion, seconded by Kadlec passed to grant.

Donald Bungert requested a permit to replace a shed with a new pole shed. Johnson motion to grant same, seconded by Sauber and passed.

Mr. and Mrs. Harold Becket requested a permit to build an earth sheltered home on Galaxie Ave (Storlie Farm) Sauber motion to grant seconded by Johnson passed.

Mr. Pepera was called up next and a letter prepared by our lawyer was read to him. Kadlec made a motion to grant a conditional use permit seconded by Sauber passed with Johnson and Sauber saying that Mr. Pepera did not need a conditional use permit. Johnson made a motion to just change the date on the permit issued by the clerk seconded by Sauber passed.

Mr. Topp came to talk to the board about the Castle Rock School. He asked the board not to sell anymore blackboards or other equipment to tear up the building. Johnson made a motion that the building would not be demolished as long as it was not costing the township any money. Seconded by Kadlec and passed. Mr. Topp had sold some desks and Johnson made a motion they could sell 34 desks and the money to go to the club. Seconded by Sauber and passed.

Mike Ryan appeared to ask for a permit to build a storage shed 10 x 16. Johnson's motion seconded by Sauber passed.

He also presented a petition about a neighbor having junked cars on his property. Zweber and Sauber to look into this matter.

Mr. Yetzer appeared to ask about road maintenance and dust control. Was told that lack of money was the problem.

Johnson and Zweber reported on road inspection trip. Johnson made a motion that Rother be instructed to apply gravel to the amount of \$6,000.00 according to roads priority as to need. Kadlec seconded and motion passed.

Kadlec has a copying machine that the township might buy is it in working condition.
