Eureka Township Board Meeting August 9, 1993

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRPERSON SCHINDLEDECKER. PRESENT WERE SUPERVISORS JOHNSON, KADLEC, SMITH AND TOPP, CLERK LEINE AND TREASURE SCHULZ.

JOHNSON MOVED TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ, SECONDED BY SMITH AND CARRIED.

KADLEC MOVED TO ACCEPT THE TREASURES REPORT, SECONDED BY TOPP AND CARRIED.

KADLEC MOVED TO PAY THE BILLS AS PRESENTED BY CLERK LEINE, SECONDED BY SMITH AND CARRIED.

TOM MOLITOR, 8875 225TH ST W, REQUEST A PERMIT FOR A 15 X 15 3 SEASONS PORCH AND A 19 X 13 DECK. THE PROJECT WAS VALUED AT \$7,107.00. TOPP MOVED TO GRANT PERMIT, SECONDED BY JOHNSON AND CARRIED.

PARTICK TUTEWOHL, 25805 FAIRGREEN AVE, REQUEST A PERMIT FOR A 12 X 32 ADDITION TO THE HOUSE, AND A 24 X 24 ATTACHED GARAGE. THIS PROJECT WAS VALUED AT \$26,964.00. JOHNSON MOVED TO GRANT PERMIT, SECONDED BY TOP? AND CARRIED.

JIM ANDERSON, 25275 IPAVA AVE, REQUESTED A 28 X 36 POLE BUILDING TO REPLACE GARAGE THAT FIRE DESTROYED. THE BUILDING TO BE SUPPLIED BY MENARDS. TOPP MOVED TO GRANT PERMIT CONTIGENT UPON THE PLANNING COMMISSION ACCEPTANCE, SECONDED BY KADLEC AND CARRIED.

DENNIS MALECHA, 9285 267TH ST W, REQUESTED A PERMIT FOR A 44 X 64 POLE BUILDING. TOPP MOVED TO GRANT PERMIT, SECONDED BY SMITH AND CARRIED.

M.A.C. AND THE CITY OF LAKEVILLE CAME BEFORE THE BOARD ASKING PERMISSION TO EXTEND AN LAKEVILLE WATERMAIN INTO EUREKA TOWNSHIP ANOTHER 800 FEET. THIS IS TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION TO THE NEW HANGERS THAT HAVE BEEN INSTALLED IN THE LAST EXPANSION. TOPP MOVED TO GRANT THE EXTENTION, SECONDED BY KADLEC AND CARRIED.

OVER THE PAST SEVERAL YEARS THE TRIBUTARIES, THAT DRAIN EUREKA TOWNSHIP, TO THE VERMILLION RIVER, HAVE NOT BEEN MAINTAINED. THESE TRIBUTARIES HAVE BEEN ALLOWED TO GROW FULL OF VEGETATION, BE FILLED WITH ROCK AND OTHER DEBRIS. THIS CONTITION HAS CAUSED SERIOUR WATER PROBLEMS FOR SOME CITIZENS OF EUREKA TOWNSHIP THIS YEAR. SOME HOUSES AND SOME SEPTIC SYSTEMS HAVE BEEN FLOODED OUT, DUE TO THE FACT THAT THESE TRIBUTARIES OF THE VERMILLION RIVER HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO FLOW PROPERLTY. THE CITIZENS OF EUREKA TOWNSHIP AFFEACTED BY THIS CONDITION ASKED THE BOARD TO TAKE UP THEIR PLEA FOR HELP FROM THE FEDERAL, STATE AND COUNTY GOVERNMENTS.

TOPP RESOLVED THAT EUREKA TOWNSHIP BOARD IS REQUESTING, THE DAKOTA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO CLEAN

OUT THE TRIBUTARIES OF THE VERMILLION RIVER IN EURERA TOWNSHIP AND

REOUEST FEDERAL DISASTER, STATE AND COUNTY FUNDING TO O SO. THIS RESOLUTION WAS SECONDED BY SMITH AND CARRIED.

JOHN ANDERSON, 8199 257TH ST W, ASKED IT 37 ACRES OF LAND IN SECTION 21 WAS BUILDABLE. THE BOARD TOLD ANDERSON IF THE LAND WAS DEEDED BEFORE APRIL 12, 1982 IS SHOULD BE A BUILDABLE PROPERTY.

JOHNSON MOVED TO ADJOURN, SECONDED BY TOPP AND CARRIED.
