After presentation of their case, a motion by Mallery 2nd by Larson to allow a permit at a rate of \$1.00 per \$100.00 valuation on an annual basis till placed on a basement at which time the regular rate for homes would apply.

Wenstad & Sundby asked for a permit to build a 4 plex on their 4 1/2 acre plot. Since it came under a commercial rating a public hearing will be held at next regular meeting date.

The matter of the closing of the bridge on 265th St by the M.N & S R.R. were next on the program. Board was to meet with Schmitz about this matter.

Bills including \$2,500.00 to Hullet were ordered paid. Farmington fire bill heldover. Clerk was instructed to order 1,000 hunting permit blanks.
