## A. Conflict of Interest Ordinance Language (per Town Board request)

MAT Attorney, Steve Fenske, recommended this NOT to be a township ordinance. It was noted that it only takes one supervisor to refuse, which would prevent a contract to be allowed. Further discussion with the Town Board and the Township attorney on the matter of this Unanimity Rule, was suggested.

#### B. Permit Forms Review

#### \*Remodel Permit-

Commissioners suggested to form two different permits with one listed as *Residential Remodel Permit-with no footprint expansion* and one titled as *Residential Remodel Permit-with footprint expansion*. To proceed with changes to this document, a verification from the Town Board about footings and setback is needed. Postponed further discussion until next month.

\*Private Kennel Operator License-

The initial application should include Private and Personal Use, along with directions stating that this is a license that needs to be renewed annually. Along with the initial application, a renewal form should be drafted.

\*Demolition Permit-

Add the acronym OTC on the form to help distinguish that this is an Over-the-Counter permit.
