A few items mentioned:


- Public Hearing was held on March 7th to establish the Redevelopment Agency.

- Nuisance Ordinance was reviewed and sent to General Code.


Old Business

Dakota County Model Mining Ordinance Workshop

Vice Chair Burkhardt and Supervisor Wood attended the first meeting. This workshop was funded by Clean Water Funds through a Minnesota Department of Health grant. The purpose was to provide Local Government Units resources to minimize impacts of aggregate mining on groundwater and surface water quality. Eureka Township's newly passed ordinance amendment is right in line with the recommendations that were presented at the meeting. The Planning Commission will compare the Township of Eureka Mineral Extraction Ordinance with a model ordinance that will be presented during the second workshop held on April 27, 2023.

New Business

Road signage

Commissioner Eilers lead this discussion regarding increased traffic on many segments of the Township roads with concerns of speed. This is in reference to a conversation that took place at a Town Board meeting and the mention of gravel roads being torn up. In addition, there is concern of semi-truck traffic and speeds on the paved portion of 250th, also known as County Rd 80.

Commissioner Eilers moved to recommend to the Town Board to request Todd Howard of Dakota County to contact the Department of Transportation on the Township's behalf to conduct a traffic study on County Road 80 between Dodd and Cedar. Chair Clancy seconded. *Roll call vote:* Randy Wood-Aye; Bill Clancy-Aye; Beth Eilers-Aye; Deb Burkhardt-Aye; *Motion carried 4-0.*

Housing Rights Property Report

Jeff Otto was invited to the meeting to give a demonstration on the database he created for the Township. He shared features and explained how this database would be a very useful tool for the clerks.

Planning Commission Vacancies

The following was discussed regarding Planning Commission Policies, in particular *Chapter 2 Establishment; Qualifications: Terms of Office*. It was asked for the Commissioners to make recommendations to the Town Board on the process of filling current vacancies.

The following was suggested:

- 1. Letters of interest should be received no later than noon on Thursday, April 6, 2023.
- 2. Ideally, citizens who are interested should include information about themselves, why they are interested in serving, and why they would be a good fit. However, since there was no process in place, a simple written statement expressing interest is acceptable.
- 3. For the future, a process needs to be in place. The Planning Commission is willing to give recommendations, however, it may not be appropriate and perhaps should be placed as an agenda item for the Town Board to work on.

It was noted that the Planning Commission Policies manual is in need of an update. It was suggested to add this to New Business at a future Planning Commission meeting.
